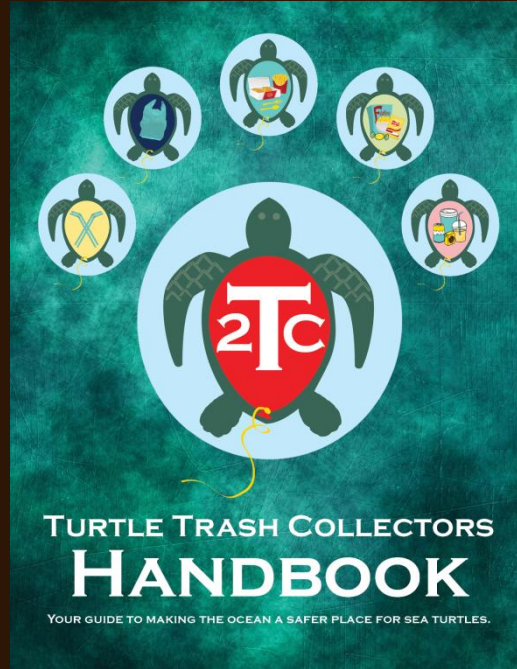




The clearinghouse and database are a free service to you as an environmental education program provider.

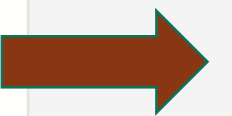
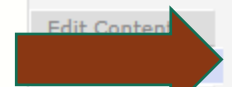

- COVID-19 Education Support**

This is for general resources related to professional development or teaching during the pandemic, and can also be any resource that could be helpful with the online or remote teaching environment.

- Online K-12 Videos and Lessons**

This is just what it says—prerecorded videos or online activities or lessons teachers can use online or in the classroom.

- Virtual K-12 Outreach Programs**

This is for live virtual field trips or distance learning for a specific group or class, when the teacher, parent etc. would request or sign up for a specific live virtual lesson, activity or experience.

- Justice, Equity, Diversity and Inclusion**
